Our **Winter Band Day** program has been designed to promote the enjoyment of music among junior high/middle school band students, 6 thru 8, who have completed (1) one full grade or year of band lessons. It offers your student a unique opportunity to learn new music, which will be performed in a same day concert. Our goal is for students to feel a sense of accomplishment; meet new friends; and relieve some tension that preparing for concerts and competitions create throughout the year. We hope you'll promote this worthwhile event with all of your students. The level of music is in the grade 2 - 3 range. As music educators, we are here to encourage and inspire students to be life-long learners in music.

The day will begin at 8:30AM and include full concert band rehearsals and group sectionals. All of our conductors and sectional instructors are area music educators and members of the Southwest Community Concert Band. **Winter Band Day** is open to any band student in grades 6-8, regardless of ability, no auditions necessary!

The **Winter Band Day** fee is **\$20.00 per student**, which includes lunch consisting of pizza, pop and a dessert. The fee can be mailed with the registration form included in the enclosed brochure or register on the day of the event.

The day will conclude with a Finale Concert featuring the **Winter Band Day** participants and a short performance by the *Southwest Community Concert Band*. The Finale Concert begins at 3:00PM, typically lasting about an hour. We would welcome your attendance; it would be a real boost to your students!
