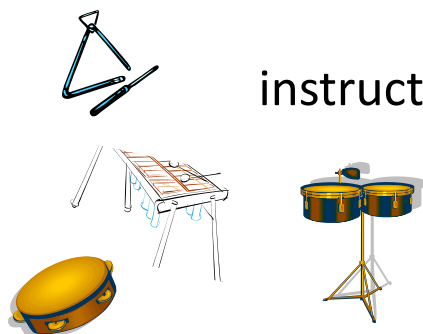

Mr. Kevin Lepper is the Director of Applied Studies as well as the Professor of Percussion at VanderCook College of Music in Chicago, Illinois. He is also an active free-lance percussionist/educator in the Chicago area.

Mr. Lepper's wide range of experiences include; El Paso Symphony, Cavaliers Drum and Bugle Corps, The Chautauqua Ensemble (world music), That Memorial Ragtime Marimba Band, and many commercial recording sessions. Mr. Lepper's experience has earned him the reputation as a "total percussionist".

Through his company (Advantage Network), he has published a series of educationally-based percussion ensembles. Kevin has also written three volumes of Boomwhackers ensembles specifically for the junior high school and beginning high school performer.

He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha fraternity and has numerous published works in the marching band medium. Mr. Lepper is also a Yamaha Performing Artist.
