*Student must register and attend the Southwest Community Concert - 2020 Band Camp to receive award.

Award—Attendance at the Southwest Community Concert Band - 2020 Summer Band Camp held June 15 – 19, 2020.

Selected by—A committee of Southwest Community Concert Band Summer Band Camp instructors.

Scholarship Definitions:

- **Southwest Community Band Area** – currently we have an active membership and audience of over 35 local communities, villages, towns, and cities.
- **Active member** – A member attending a majority of the Southwest Community Concert Bands rehearsals, concerts and band functions.
- **All scholarship awards** – will be selected by the above named and will be approved by the Southwest Community Concert Band board members.
